elected to office before the withdrawal period is over, if the number of nominations received does not exceed the number of offices to be filled. The usual practice is for the Returning Officer to declare results after the withdrawal

period has expired.

Rule 49.16 implies that a scrutineer can observe the consideration of nomination forms, inspect and observe the form and distribution of ballot papers. AEC policy is not to disclose information regarding nomination forms prior to

closing time.

It is usual practice to have ticks or crosses in a first past the post voting system.
